



## Day 12 of the war of aggression against Iran (Ticker 10:30 a.m.)

**The now 12-day-long war of aggression waged by the US and Israel against Iran has brought destruction and death to the region and driven ever-increasing energy prices worldwide. These prices will not fall again anytime soon because production and shipping facilities have been destroyed. Here are the developments from the night of March 10, 2026, until the end of March 11.**

Yesterday evening, starting at 8 p.m. German time, the conflict between the US, Israel, and Iran escalated further, with the US [conducting](#) Iran's missile capabilities [its most intensive airstrikes since the beginning of the war](#). [These attacks targeted Iranian military installations, including command centers and missile bases in Tehran and other regions, and have further weakened.](#)

Simultaneously, Israeli forces launched attacks on Hezbollah positions in Beirut, triggering explosions in the southern suburbs of the Lebanese capital, [in an effort](#) to occupy southern Lebanon, as planned since 1967. It has not yet been reported that the terrorist organization HTS, now the "Syrian Transitional Government," which was massing troops on Lebanon's western border, has opened a second front against the Hezbollah resistance movement. Nor has the Lebanese army, despite pressure from the US, yet allowed itself to be drawn into starting a civil war to facilitate the invasion of southern Lebanon by Israeli troops.

Iran responded with several missile salvos against Israel, including three night attacks between March 10 and 11, some of which were intercepted and, according to Israel, did not [cause](#) serious damage .

US President Donald Trump signaled in a press conference that the war [could end](#) in the short term , but stressed the possibility of escalation if Iran disrupted oil traffic in the Strait of Hormuz. Iranian officials reported over 1,300 deaths since the start of the war and accused the US and Israel of attacking civilian targets such as schools, drawing international [criticism](#) .

On the night of March 11, Iranian forces fired further missiles at US bases in the region, including in Kuwait, where two missiles struck without [any casualties](#) . causing

German Chancellor Friedrich Merz expressed concern about the lack of a clear [exit plan](#) from the conflict between the US and Israel.

By the morning of March 11, further Israeli airstrikes on Iranian targets had been reported, while Iran continued drone attacks on oil infrastructure in Bahrain and Saudi Arabia, impacting oil [markets](#) .

As reported yesterday, Israel has now forced 700,000 people to flee Lebanon. **France will Lebanon with 60 tons of humanitarian aid , French Foreign Minister Jean-Noel Barrot announced on Wednesday.** provide

“We have decided to triple the volume of aid that will arrive this week. This aid includes... 60 tons of humanitarian aid for the Lebanese, including sanitary kits, hygiene kits, mattresses, lamps and also a mobile medical station,” Barrot said in an interview with the French radio station TF1.

**Israeli attacks** targeted an **apartment building in central Beirut** on Wednesday , Lebanese state media reported. This was the second attack in the city in just a few days.

Iran's new supreme leader, **Mojtaba Khamenei** , is "well" despite reports of injury sustained during the war with Israel and the United States, the Iranian president's son said on Wednesday.

“I heard the news that Mr. Mojtaba Khamenei had been injured. I asked some friends who have connections. They told me that, thank God, he is doing well,” **Yousef Pezeshkian** wrote in a post on his Telegram channel.

A **bulk carrier** was hit by an unidentified projectile 50 nautical miles northwest of Dubai (United Arab Emirates) on Wednesday, the **UK Maritime Trade Organization (UKMTO)**

said.

The crew is safe and the authorities are investigating the incident, according to UKMTO.

Two **drones** crashed near **Dubai airport** on Wednesday , injuring four people, the Dubai media office said.

**Air traffic is proceeding normally** , it added.

**9:30 a.m.**

this morning in a **drone attack** on a vehicle in the Saf al-Hawa area of Bint Jbeil **Three people were killed** , as reported by the Lebanese National News Agency.

Another **drone attack** targeted the **town of Barashit in the Bint Jbei district** , injuring two Syrians, one of them seriously, the agency reported. The injured were taken to the state hospital in Tebnine.

**Isfahan** experienced a "bloody night" with **bombing attacks on archaeological and historical sites** , Al Jazeera reported, citing the governor of the province.

A **US airstrike** on residential areas in **Lamerd, Fars province, Iran** according to Iranian sources , **killed 20 civilians** , . Several houses and a sports hall were hit. The missile exploded in mid-air near buildings, with shrapnel causing extensive damage.

### **Rocket attacks** on Jerusalem.

A rocket struck near **Beit Shemesh** , not far from occupied Jerusalem, with plumes of smoke rising from the impact site.

Last night, the US and Israel **an Iranian civilian bank (Sepah)** on Haghani Highway in Tehran **bombed** . The attack killed several **bank employees** who were working overtime to prepare payroll. In response, Iranian forces warned everyone in the area to stay within 1 km of any banks affiliated with the US or Israel, as these are now among their targets.

In the preceding days, Israel also carried **out targeted attacks on banks in Lebanon** . This, too, appears to be a method used to make life more difficult for civilians.

The **Iranian military** has announced it will launch attacks against **US and Israeli economic targets** in the region. "The enemy has given us free rein to attack economic centers and banks of the United States and the Zionist regime," declared Khatam Al-Anbiya, the military's central operations command, in a statement broadcast on state television.

### **EU-Parliament:**

Dissatisfaction **with Ursula von der Leyen is growing** within the European Parliament and could jeopardize her position, Politico reports, citing sources. Members of Parliament plan to question and criticize von der Leyen sharply today over her recent statement that "Europe can no longer be the guardian of the old world order, a world that is gone and will not return." Some interpreted this statement as support for Donald Trump's policies.

“I hope that President von der Leyen will clarify these statements, which surprised and angered me and my group,” said **Iratxe García, leader of the center-left Socialists and**

**Democrats group** . “We cannot accept questioning the need to defend the international order.”

Spanish S&D MP Jonás Fernández said that von der Leyen was "practically asking for a vote of no confidence".

Three diplomats told Politico that the European Parliament is quickly becoming the biggest threat to the end of von der Leyen's term in office.
