The open lies of German politicians and the media

On Thursday, Defense Minister Pistorius claimed that Putin had "clearly said" he wanted to attack Europe after Ukraine. Other Western politicians, "journalists" and "experts" also claim this. Why are they so blatantly lying?



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<u>The Handelsblatt quoted</u> from a speech by Federal Defense Minister Pistorius on Thursday evening:

"German Defense Minister Boris Pistorius (SPD) has compared Russian President Waldimir Putin's attack on Ukraine to Nazi Germany's annexation of Czechoslovakia in 1938. Europe must prepare for a long war, said Pistorius on the sidelines of the launch of a book about Winston Churchill.

"Putin will not stop when the war against Ukraine is over, he has said that clearly," said Pistorius. "Just as clear as Hitler, who always said he wouldn't stop."

The lies in the West

Let's ignore the fact that Pistorius compares Putin with Hitler, because the Hitler comparisons are now used so excessively in Germany that this is actually a case for the public prosecutor, because trivializing the crimes of the Nazi regime is punishable in Germany. If this provision were taken seriously, many German "journalists" and "politicians" would long ago have to answer for themselves in court, because who hasn't equated everything with Hitler in recent years?

This is about something different. I showed the quote from the Handelsblatt in its entirety so that no one can accuse me of taking something out of context. But what I'm interested in is this statement from Pistorius:

"Putin will not stop when the war against Ukraine is over, he has said that clearly"

What did Putin say? And when?

Lying to distract from the consequences of one's own politics

We are currently experiencing the greatest loss of prosperity that Germany has seen since the war. Real incomes have fallen more sharply than ever before in the history of the Federal Republic.

And so it is with the lying claims that Putin has "clearly stated" that he wants to attack other countries in Europe after Ukraine.

There is only one thing that matters: the population in Europe should accept the loss of prosperity and be made "ready for war". Incidentally, it is Pistorius who speaks at every opportunity that the Bundeswehr and German society should be "ready for war". Sometimes these people are very open and honest.

Europe is being talked into war

But why is it all? Do they want a war in Europe? I don't want to believe that they are so unworldly that they think this is a good idea.

What Putin really says

Putin was asked by an officer about military spending in various countries around the world and I fully translated his answer.

Putin: If we look at military spending: Let's take military spending for 2022, because figures for 2023 are still being summarized and for 2024 it is too early to say anything at all. According to our data, we spent 3.5 percent of GDP on defense. Let's not take our data, let's take data from the Stockholm Peace Institute, international data, which has this calculation: the USA spent 3.5 percent of GDP on defense, Russia four percent. And let's say Israel 4.5 percent. Ukraine spent 33.5 percent in 2022.

But how big is the difference in absolute numbers? In 2022, if I remember correctly, the US spent \$811 billion and Russia spent \$72 billion. 72 and 811, the difference is clear, more than ten times. The United States accounts for approximately 40 percent of global defense spending and the United States accounts for 39 percent of global spending. And Russia accounts for 3.5 percent. Given this relationship, will we go to war with NATO? This is simply nonsense.

Besides, what are we doing now in the military operation? We defend our people who live in our historic territories.

If we had built entirely new security relationships in Europe after the collapse of the Soviet Union, as Russia suggested, none of what we see today would have happened. If only they

had taken into account our security interests, which we have talked about year after year, basically decade after decade. They just completely ignored her. They have reached our borders. Did we reach the borders of the countries that were then part of the NATO bloc? We are not. They have moved to us. Did we cross the ocean to the US borders? No, they came to us, very close. And what we do? We are only protecting our people in our historic areas. So the claim that we would attack Europe after Ukraine is complete nonsense.

Soldier: This is fear mongering.

Putin: They scare their own people solely to get money out of them. Especially given the fact that their economy is shrinking and living standards are falling. That's obvious. Everyone admits that, it's not propaganda, it happens in reality. They have to justify themselves, so they scare their population with a possible "Russian threat" while they themselves extend their dictates to the entire world.

NATO is the organization of the North Atlantic bloc, the North Atlantic. And where is she going now? It's going to the Asia-Pacific region, the Middle East, other regions of the world, it's even going to Latin America. And it's always the same under different pretexts: They get NATO there and drag their European satellites behind them. They seem to believe that this all somehow corresponds to their national interests; they are afraid of a big, strong Russia, even though that makes no sense.

Nevertheless, we adhered to the Minsk Agreement. But no, as it turns out, we were cheated, we were stalled for eight years, and in the end we were simply forced to switch to another form of defense of our interests and our people. That's all.

That's why it's complete nonsense, the possibility of attacking any other countries, Poles, the Balts, even the Czechs scare them. This is simply nonsense, this is just another way to cheat your own population and impose additional costs on people so that they carry the burden on their shoulders. That's all.
