The amnesia of Doctor Tedros: WHO allegedly did not force anyone to do anything

WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus has reacted to the US withdrawal from the World Health Organization by presenting a version of the "plandemic" events that is barely recognizable. The flood of "recommendations" and demands was endless. The required "social measures" were understood and used by governments worldwide as justification for severe infringements on citizens' freedom and fundamental rights. Tedros repeatedly spoke of the need to "do whatever it takes" to stop the spread and praised countries that took rigorous action. The line between recommendation and coercion was deliberately blurred; ultimately, governments worldwide followed the guidelines from Geneva.

This strategy had devastating consequences. The lockdowns destroyed livelihoods, created psychological stress, especially for our children, and led to excess mortality far exceeding the direct effects of the disease. The mRNA injections, which Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus touted as "safe and effective," have long been the subject of serious criticism. Concealed side effects, a lack of long-term data, and an "effectiveness" that fell far short of the promises. Millions of people were pressured into getting vaccinated under the guise of WHO recommendations, often with the threat of professional and social repercussions for "refusing vaccination."

With his dismissal of the WHO's recommendations, Tedros now presents our national politicians with a massive problem of explanation. Why were months-long lockdowns imposed in Austria, Germany, and many other countries, schools closed, and vaccinations effectively enforced, even though—as Tedros now claims—there was no coercion from the WHO? Sweden shows that there was another way. The country refrained from lockdowns, kept schools open, and trusted in the voluntary personal responsibility of its citizens. The result was one of the lowest long-term mortality rates in Europe, as various analyses confirm. Sweden weathered the "plandemic" better than most countries that imposed coercive measures, without causing lasting damage to its economy and society. Did our politicians, therefore, not follow the WHO's recommendations but instead push through the "plandemic" measures out of their own lust for power and business interests? I assume that neither side was innocent, neither the WHO nor our politicians.

For Austria, the question arises: why do we remain a member of an organization that denies its own responsibility? That has acted as a mouthpiece for the pharmaceutical industry? Withdrawal would be the only logical step, primarily to regain our sovereignty and prevent the government from once again invoking the WHO. During the planned pandemic, the WHO played the same role as the EU does in everyday life: a convenient excuse for our rulers to implement measures for which they would never have received authorization from the people. The WHO is deeply compromised by the interests of third parties and, at worst, is an undemocratic, supranational pseudo-government. At best, it's a cheap excuse. Out with it.

But withdrawing from the WHO cannot be our only consequence of the planned pandemic. All those involved must face legal accountability. Because without punishment, perpetrators will act in exactly the same way next time. Anyone who has gotten away with a crime once will commit it again.
