
Eurostat figures revealed: Europe in the migration tsunami as a UN-led project — Germany leads the way with 16.9 million immigrants!

Numbers that speak for themselves

Over 16.9 million foreign-born people in Germany, more than 50% migrants in Luxembourg, almost 70% in Liechtenstein. Even small island states such as Malta now have a third of immigrants.

By way of comparison, Switzerland is also in an OECD comparison with around **31 %** Proportion of people born in another country among the highest values.

On the other hand, Eastern Europe, where the share is sometimes less than 5%. It shows what happens when a country defies the migration dogma: political isolation, massive pressure from Brussels and the UN institutions.

The UN Global Compact for Migration as a master plan

This development is no coincidence. Since the adoption of the <u>Global Compact for Migration</u> (<u>GCM</u>)) 2018 the direction is clear: migration should no longer be considered the exception, but rather "normal" and "positive".

- **Migration as a human right:** The pact defines migration not as a risk, but as a desired reality that must be promoted and facilitated.
- **Narrative control:** Criticism of the pact or mass immigration is branded as "disinformation" a frontal attack on freedom of expression.
- **Integration as a duty:** Host countries should restructure structures from schools to the labour market in order not only to accept migration, but to actively promote it.

This makes it clear that the enormous figures that Eurostat is now providing are not a "spontaneous development", but the result of a **politically orchestrated agenda**.

The consequences in everyday life: insecurity, violence, fear

The bitter reality: **Migrant attacks are now the order of the day in almost all European countries.** Knife attacks on trains, gang rapes, brawls in city centres – there is hardly a country that is not affected.

The **Population was never asked**, whether it wants this migration policy. It is simply being implemented – over the heads of the citizens. The result: Europe is becoming noticeably more insecure, from Paris to Berlin to Stockholm.

Women are particularly hard hit: In many Western European cities, it is now risky for them to be alone at night. Entire neighbourhoods have become **No-Go-Zonen** in which the police are only hesitantly present.

And there is no end in sight. On the contrary, the situation worsens with each new wave of immigration. Politicians are reacting with language regulations, not with protective measures.

The Role of Big Tech and Media

Particularly perfidious: While the figures are publicly available, discussions about them **algorithmically thwarted, censored or defamed**. This is exactly where the alliance of UN institutions, Western governments and the major platforms comes into play.

The narrative is: "Migration is unavoidable." Anything else is dismissed as agitation.

Europe in restructuring – without a mandate from the citizens

Eurostat data not only show demographic trends – they document the **Europe's biggest silent** transformation since the Second World War.

- In Germany, a parallel society is growing, while political elites bury any criticism under "reasons of state".
- In Western Europe, the majority population is becoming a minority in more and more cities.
- In Eastern Europe, on the other hand, governments are resisting the implementation of the pact and are regularly sanctioned and attacked by Brussels for this.

Conclusion: An agenda against the peoples of Europe

The sober figures from Luxembourg, Germany or Malta are the statistical proof: **Migration is no longer a spontaneous event, but a controlled policy.**

The UN migration pact provided the script, Brussels and Big Tech are enforcing it, and national governments are playing along – against the declared will of large parts of their populations.

Europe is being restructured. Not through open debates, but through technocratic decisions.

The Eurostat chart is not a product of chance – it is a glimpse into the future if this agenda continues unabated.
